Now celebrating its 59th ride, thousands of St. Louis bicyclists take to the streets, every summer, to take part in this unique, family-friendly event. The ride offers a shorter 7-10 mile route and a longer 14-18 mile route.

The event includes a leisurely bike ride through the streets of St. Louis, food trucks, a vendor/booth area, a commemorative event shirt, and an after-ride party with drinks, live music, and the opportunity to be a part of a St. Louis tradition which keeps riders coming back year after year.
